Kennedy Catholic is proud to be partnering with PACE University's "Lubin School of Business" and is offering college credit courses. PACE courses are 150 per credit (\$450 per class) and are payable to PACE University. All fees are subject to change and all courses will be taught at Kennedy Catholic. PACE courses may be taken individually or as a senior elective.

Business courses may fulfill a senior elective requirement provided two (2) semester courses are taken or (1) fully year course is taken during an academic school year.

Business 101 is a required course for all business courses at Kennedy Catholic.
