- 1. *Night* by Elie Wiesel
- 2. The Count of Monte Cristo by Alexandre Dumas

Purchase the translated and **abridged** version by Lowell Bair, Bantam Classics not the 1000-page version.

3. *I Am Malal*a by Malala Yousafzai - do not purchase the juvenile version

Texts must be purchased so that students can annotate while reading. <u>Used books are great</u> and can be found on Amazon or from the upperclassmen. Do not be concerned if these books are already annotated - you can use a different color pen.

Instructions

- Write your name across the outer top edge of the book.

- Annotate – As this is your first attempt at annotation - **brief** 1 or 2 word handwritten notes in margins (not on every page and no post-its) - on information about characters, setting, point of view, themes. DO NOT SUMMARIZE STORY. We will review annotations in class which may be graded.

- Multiple choice test for each novel will be administered after classroom discussion.

Essay – DO NOT CONSULT INTERNET FOR IDEAS

On the first day of class I will instruct you on how to upload your essay onto Canvas. Write a 3 paragraph essay on I Am Malala by Malala Yousafzai Essay can be no more than 1 page, doubled spaced, Times New Roman, 12 Pt.

Introduction Paragraph

- Title, Author, Genre (novel)

- Identify the CENTRAL IDEA (or theme) of *I Am Malal*a and choose <u>one</u> WRITING STRATEGY (characterization, setting, points of view) which helps you to understand your central idea. Everyone will have different CENTRAL IDEAS – there is no one message – so trust your instincts.

Paragraph 2

- Give 2 specific example of your chosen Writing Strategy and explain how it helps you
- understand the Central Idea you have learned from I Am Malala.
- Paragraph 3 Conclusion
